Launched in October 2011

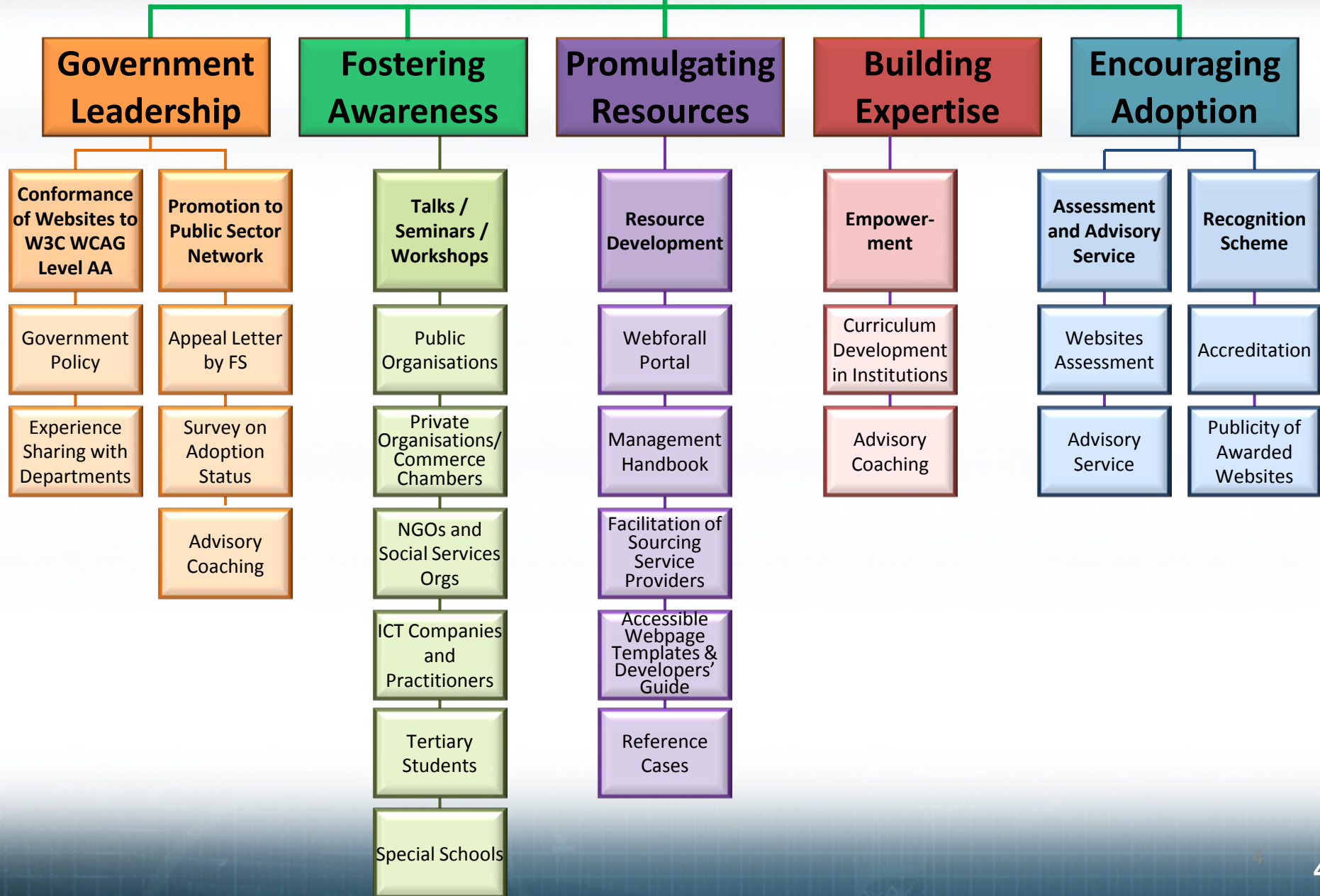
## Objective

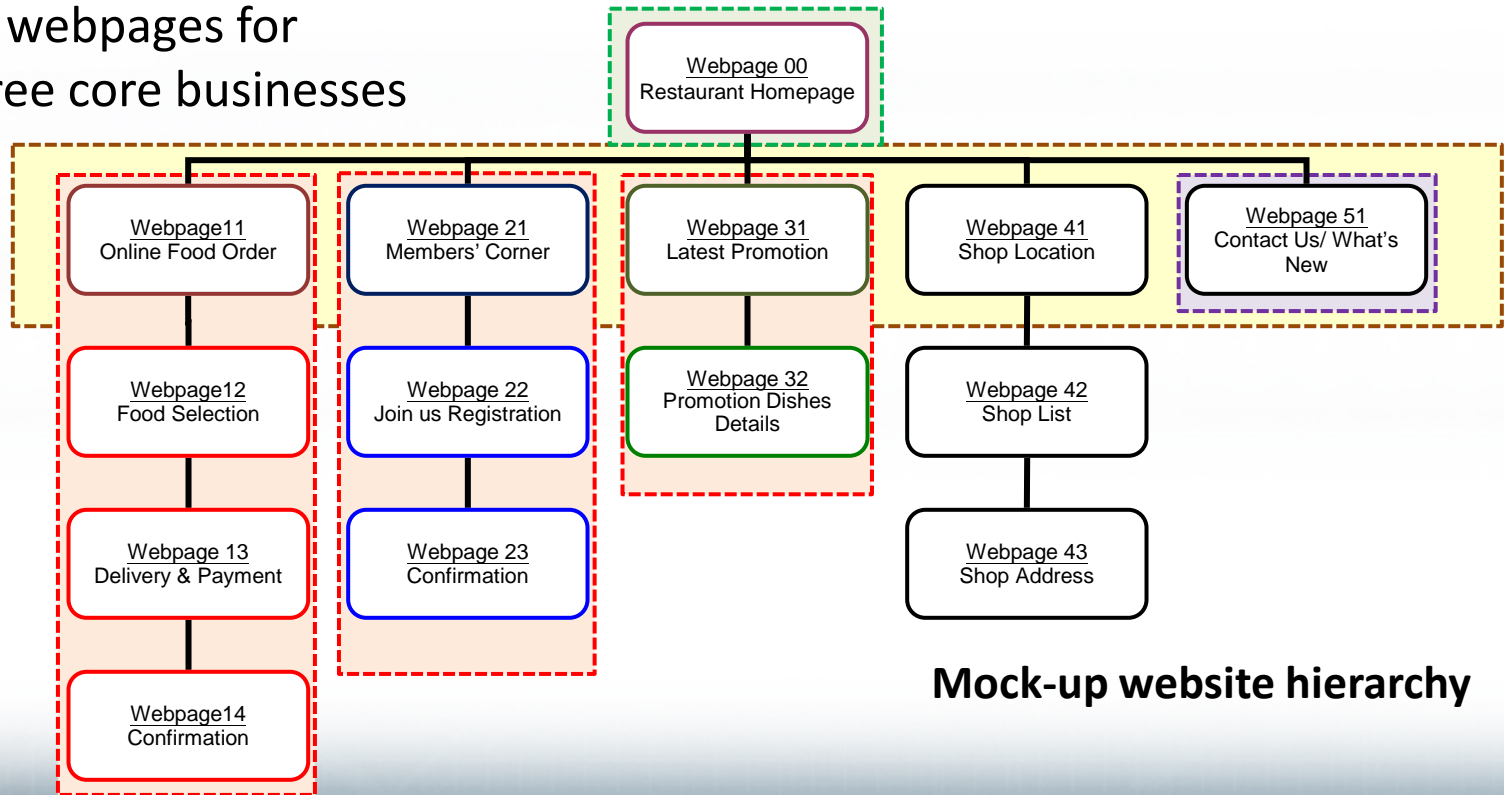

## *Awards – Website Stream (Continue)*

### Most Favourite Websites<sup>NEW</sup>

- Gold Awardee websites are automatically entered into the contest
- Vote by members from five needy groups
  - visual impairment
  - physical impairment
  - hearing impairment
  - cognitive impairment
  - elderly

## Judging Criteria – Website Stream (Silver)



No.	Criteria
1	Provide meaningful text alternative for non-text contents
2	Provide accessible Flash/Animated content or allow to skip
3	Allow to perform all operations through a keyboard interface
4	Easy to turn off background sound or set as user-initiated only
5	Provide means to close popup windows
6	Provide clear and informative links
7	Provide accurate and appropriate headings/labels
8	Make website content easy to be used with assistive technologies
9	Make website structure in a consistent navigation mechanism
10	Make website content in meaningful sequence <b>NEW</b>
11	Provide input assistance such as proper labels for user input and error identification and description etc.
12	Provide error prevention for transactions
13	Text can be resized up to 200 percent without loss of content *
14	Provide an accessibility statement with contact points for the website *

## Judging Criteria – Website Stream (Gold)

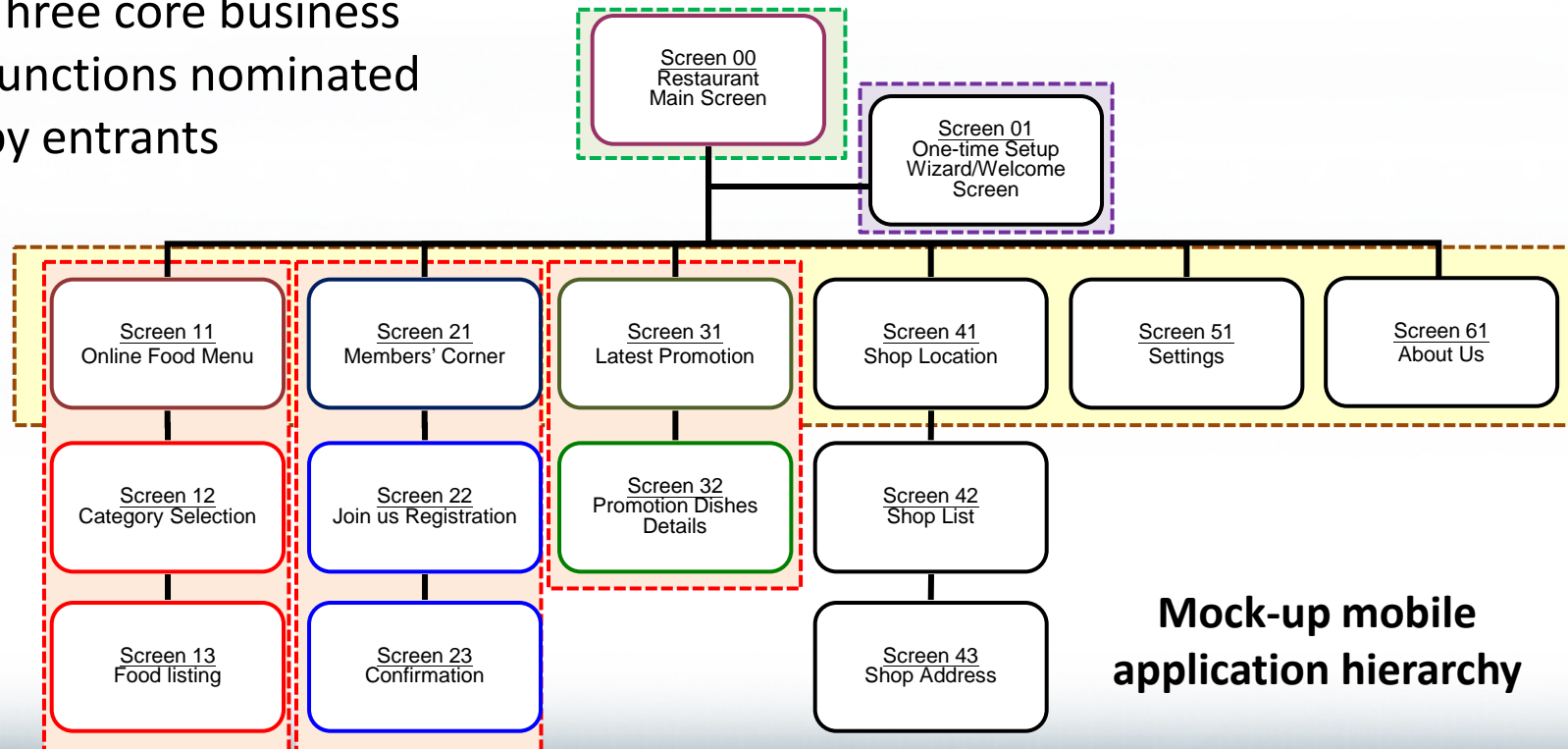


No.	Criteria
1	Provide accessible PDFs <b>NEW</b>
2	Build webpages with predictable operations
3	Able to skip repetitive blocks
4	Provide multiple ways to retrieve content <b>NEW</b>
5	Build webpages with user-initiated auto-updating
6	Provide sufficient time for users to read the content and operate the function
7	Provide sufficient colour contrast
8	Ensure correct syntax of webpages for compatibility with browsers and assistive technologies
9	Provide captions or sign language for <b>30%</b> of pre-recorded videos published in the recent 2 years
10	Provide meaningful title, summary or description for table headers as well as data

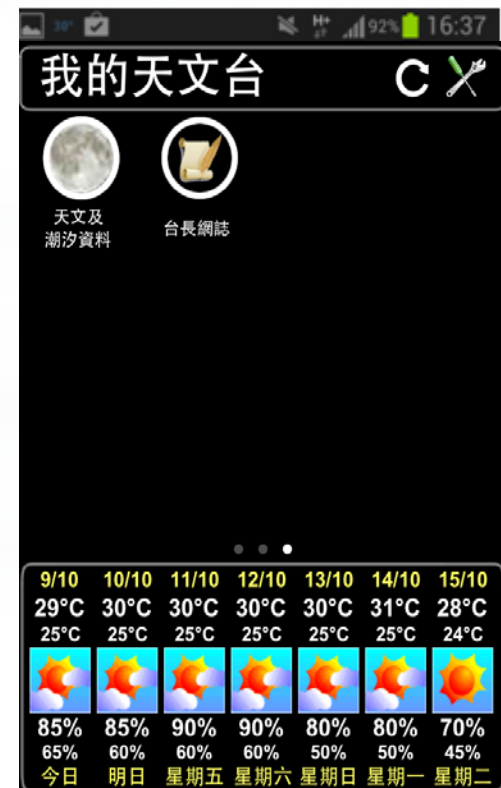

## Judging Criteria – Mobile Application Stream (Silver)

No.	Criteria
1	Provide meaningful text alternative for non-text contents
2	Easy to turn off background sound or set as user-initiated only
3	Make all clickable objects large enough to be tapped #
4	Provide clear and simple headings
5	Provide consistent and simple user interface structure
6	Provide meaningful content sequence
7	Provide navigation for going backward #
8	Provide clear and informative links
9	Text resize function or text can be zoomed without loss of content
10	Compatible with screen readers

# Applicable to Mobile Applications only



## Judging Criteria – Mobile Application Stream (Gold)

No.	Criteria
1	Provide sufficient colour contrast
2	Provide sufficient time for users to read the content and operate the function
3	Provide captions or sign language for 30% of pre-recorded videos published in the recent 2 years
4	Provide alternative means for notification #
5	Provide input assistance such as proper labels or instructions for user input
6	Provide error prevention for transactions
7	Provide means to close popovers
8	Provide contact points or “email feedback” feature

## Common Q&As

### Application-related

**Q1 : Can an organisation submit more than one application?**

**A1 : Yes.** Main homepage, thematic websites, mobile applications are welcome, please use individual form.

**Q2 : Can we apply after deadline? What if our website revamp schedule/mobile application release is after 31 December 2013?**

**A2 : Application is not preferred after deadline.** Initial assessment can be performed on testing website or beta version of mobile application.

**Q3 : Can I nominate other organisation to apply?**

**A3 : Yes but ensure the organisation name should be the entrant and the organisation chop is stamped.**

# Web Accessibility Recognition Scheme

---

## Application-related

**Q4: Which stream should I apply for a mobile website?**

A4: A mobile website is basically a website, hence application via Website Stream is recommended.

**Q5: Which stream should I apply for a web app?**

A5: A web app is similar to a mobile app but does not require downloading and installation. A web app relies on browser software to run. In general, application via Mobile Application Stream is recommended.

# Web Accessibility Recognition Scheme

---

## Past entrant-related

**Q6 : Do 2012-13 Entrants need to submit application form again?**

**A6 : Yes.**

**Q7 : Can the 3 core business functions be the same as the last year?**

**A7 : Highly recommended to nominate other 3 core business functions, if available.**

**Organisers may counter-propose other business functions.**



# Web Accessibility Recognition Scheme

---

## Assessment-related

**Q8 : Can we receive a second assessment before final assessment?**

A8 : Officially no. Advisory services (through phone, email, technical workshops and meetings) and scanning reports will be available.

**Q9 : What if there are still non-conforming items found in final assessment?**

A9 : To be handled case by case. We accept minor ones which can be fixed within an agreed timeframe.

\*May affect the “My Favourite Website Award”.

### Q10: How to enhance accessibility for multi-media contents?

A10: Scenarios	Minimum level under special circumstances
New video	Follow judging criteria G09; May consider <i>audio description</i>
Corporate video	Follow judging criteria G09
Video posted in social media platform	Follow judging criteria G09
Guest speaker video	Provide presentation slides and/or a summary
Video without source	Provide a summary and/or script
Video without script	Provide a summary
Third party video	Provide a description or summary



**A11: Follow website judging criteria G01 where applicable.**



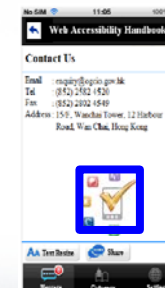
# Web Accessibility Recognition Scheme

## Award-related

**Q12: Is there any requirement on where to display the award?**

**A12: Awarded organisations may display the Award Logo on -**

- front-page, first screen, contact us screen, app icon;
- those entitled webpages, screens;
- marketing items (e.g. name card, letterhead and envelope...)
- promotional materials (e.g. leaflet, poster, advertisement...)
