Under "Big data analytics", the development of "advanced decision-making capabilities" can only be useful if the underlying data is of sufficient quality, in terms of being modelled correctly and meeting rules and guidelines for data. Mention of the Semantic Web in this area is useful as it gives us the (guaranteed) framework to make reliable decisions from large data sources.

Under "Public Sector Information (PSI) as Default", the development of Linked Open Data paradigm is useful for government data. LOD provides reliable links to government data and "semantic" information about that data/service. This will enable and foster more third-party reuse and better value for money.
