I had already travel to Singapore and discover some electronic learning strategy. One of them is as follows:

1. The government provides a platform for school to store their teaching material temporarily.
2. The school can load their teaching material for field trip
3. At the place of learning (such as museum), the student can use their mobile devices to access to the relevant materials through Internet.
4. At the same time, the teacher can monitor the learning condition of the student, take some test, mark the result, and perform other teaching tasks.

Another electronic learning strategy is paperless test:

1. The school lodge the test paper into the school platform or government platform for school.
2. The student log into the web site, and then answer the test question.

I think that the above electronic learning strategy can reduce the paper consumption, and hereby protect the environment; A the same time, it can provide interactive learning between the teacher and the student.

In my opinion, the above electronic learning strategy can be used by Hong Kong SAR government.
